Sets forth the rule for the consideration of H.R. 2185 (extending the Temporary Extended Unemployment Compensation Act of 2002).

- **May 21, 2003:** Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 2185 with 1 hour of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit with or without instructions. Bill is closed to amendments.
- **May 21, 2003:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 47.
