Summary (as of May 5, 2004)

(This measure has not been amended since it was reported to the House on April 2, 2004. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Small Public Housing Authority Act - Amends the United States Housing Act of 1937 to exempt a small public housing agency from the requirement to prepare an annual public agency plan if the agency: (1) administers not more than a total of 100 dwelling units and section 8 vouchers; (2) is not a troubled agency; and (3) provides assurances of public housing resident participation.
