Summary (as of Jul 25, 2003)

Nuclear Accountability Act - Prohibits operation of any nuclear utilization facility unless the Nuclear Regulatory

Commission finds that the State in which the facility is located, as well as each affected county or county equivalent located within a ten-mile radius, has certified within the last year a radiological emergency response plan which provides reasonable assurance that public health and safety are not endangered by the operation of the facility.
