Summary (as of Jun 26, 2003)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Authorizes the Speaker of the House of Representatives, during the remainder of the 108th Congress, to entertain motions that the House suspend the rules on Wednesdays, as under rule XV (Business in Order on Special Days).

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 26, 2003:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 108-179, by Mr. Linder.
- **Jun 26, 2003:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 73.
- **Jun 26, 2003:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H5946-5951)
- **Jun 26, 2003:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 297.
- **Jun 26, 2003:** The previous question was ordered without objection.
- **Jun 26, 2003:** POSTPONED ROLL CALL VOTE - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 297, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. McGovern demanded Yeas and Nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of adoption of the resolution until later in the legislative day.
- **Jun 26, 2003:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H5973-5974)
- **Jun 26, 2003:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 226 - 203 (Roll no. 323).(text: CR H5946)
- **Jun 26, 2003:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 226 - 203 (Roll no. 323). (text: CR H5946)
- **Jun 26, 2003:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
