### Summary (as of Sep 17, 2003)

Amends the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946 to prohibit adjustments in the pay rates for Members of Congress from exceeding any cost-of-living increases in benefits under title II (Old Age, Survivors and Disability Insurance) (OASDI) of the Social Security Act.

### Actions Timeline

- **Oct 9, 2003:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Civil Service and Agency Organization.
- **Sep 17, 2003:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 17, 2003:** Referred to the Committee on House Administration, and in addition to the Committee on Government Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
