Department of the Treasury Inspector General Consolidation Act of 2003 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to establish in the Department of the Treasury the Office of the Treasury Inspector General to consolidate the two existing Inspector General offices at the U.S. Treasury.

- **Nov 22, 2003:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E2395)
- **Nov 21, 2003:** Introduced in House
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- **Nov 21, 2003:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Government Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
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
