Congressional Accountability for Judicial Activism Act of 2004 - Authorizes Congress, if two thirds of each House agree, to reverse a judgment of the United States Supreme Court: (1) if that judgment is handed down after the date of the enactment of this Act; and (2) to the extent that judgment concerns the constitutionality of an Act of Congress.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 2, 2004:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Courts, the Internet, and Intellectual Property.
- **Mar 9, 2004:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 9, 2004:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Rules, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Mar 4, 2004:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR H845-846)

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
