Congratulates the San Jose Earthquakes for winning the 2003 Major League Soccer Cup. Recognizes the achievement of the Earthquake's players, coaches, staff, and supporters in bringing the Soccer Cup to San Jose. Commends the San Jose community for its enthusiastic support of the Earthquakes. Expresses the hope that Major League Soccer will continue to inspire fans and young players by producing teams of the Earthquake's high caliber.
