Declares that the House of Representatives offers its gratitude to the seven Space Shuttle Columbia astronauts and its heartfelt sympathy to their families on the anniversary of their loss, with the reassurance that this sacrifice will not have been made in vain, but will strengthen this Nation's resolve to continue their journey of discovery.

#### **Actions Timeline**

- Feb 3, 2004: Mr. Burgess moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- Feb 3, 2004: Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H258-263)
- Feb 3, 2004: DEBATE The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 507.
- Feb 3, 2004: At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
