### **Summary** (as of Sep 28, 2004)

Amends title XIX (Medicaid) of the Social Security Act to extend through September 2005 Medicare cost-sharing for the Medicare part B premium for qualifying individuals for additional low-income medicare beneficiaries.

Revises requirements for the total allocation amount for three specified periods between January 1, 2004, and September 30, 2005.
