### Summary (as of Feb 5, 2003)

Amends the Colorado Enabling Act to permit the State of Colorado to use land held in trust by the State for the support of common schools for open space, wildlife habitat, scenic value, or other natural values, with the requirement that any income received from using the land shall be used only for common schools.
