Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 444) to amend the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 to establish a Personal Reemployment Accounts grant program to assist Americans in returning to work.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 2, 2004:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H3611-3617; text of measure as reported in House: CR H3611)
- **Jun 2, 2004:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 656.
- **Jun 2, 2004:** POSTPONED VOTE - At the conclusion of debate the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question on the amendment and on the resolution and by voice vote announced that the ayes had prevailed. Ms. Slaughter demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the amendment and on the resolution until later in the legislative day.
- **Jun 2, 2004:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H3626-3628)
- **Jun 2, 2004:** UNFINISHED BUSINESS - The Chair announced that the unfinished business was the question of adoption of the previous question on the Pryce amendment and on H. Res. 656 itself, both of which had been debated earlier and on which further proceedings had been postponed.
- **Jun 2, 2004:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 214 - 196 (Roll no. 215). (consideration: CR H3626)
- **Jun 2, 2004:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 220 - 196 (Roll no. 217).
- **Jun 2, 2004:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 220 - 196 (Roll no. 217).
- **Jun 2, 2004:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.

In the engrossment of H.R. 444, the Clerk shall add the texts of H.R. 4409 and H.R. 4410 as new matter at the end of H.R. 444 and then lay H.R. 4409 and H.R. 4410 on the table.
