Summary (as of Feb 11, 2003)

Clinical Social Work Medicare Equity Act of 2003 - Amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act to exclude clinical social worker services from coverage under the Medicare skilled nursing facility prospective payment system (thus permitting direct payment under the Medicare program for clinical social worker services provided to residents of skilled nursing facilities).

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 26, 2003:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Chairman.
- **Feb 21, 2003:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Feb 11, 2003:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 11, 2003:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E182)
- **Feb 11, 2003:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

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
