Summary (as of Mar 26, 2003)

Help for America's Uninsured Act of 2003 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to permit an individual to designate a portion of any tax overpayment for the Health Coverage for the Uninsured Trust Fund, which shall use such funds to provide injury and catastrophic illness protection to individuals without health coverage.

Establishes the Health Coverage for the Uninsured Trust Fund.
