### Summary (as of Jan 7, 2003)

Strengthen the Public Health Service Act - Amends the Public Health Service Act to make certain graduate programs in professional psychology eligible to participate in various health professions loan programs.

Revises provisions concerning the collection of health professions data, sex discrimination in medical education programs, and definitions to make these applicable to "professional" (rather than "clinical") psychologists.
