Health Benefits Claims Prompt Payment Act of 2003 - Amends the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, the Internal Revenue Code, and the Public Health Service Act to require that group and individual health insurance coverage and group health plans provide for prompt payment for health benefits claims.

### Actions Timeline

- **Mar 10, 2003:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Employer-Employee Relations.
- **Feb 26, 2003:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Feb 13, 2003:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 13, 2003:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Education and the Workforce, and Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
