Medicare Infertility Coverage Act of 2003 - Amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act (SSA) to provide coverage under the Medicare program of infertility treatment services for individuals entitled to health insurance benefits under that program by reason of a disability.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 17, 2003:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 14, 2003:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Feb 27, 2003:** Introduced in House
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- **Feb 27, 2003:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
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
