Summary (as of Feb 27, 2003)

Small Savers Relief Act of 2003 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to exclude up to \$100 (\$200 for joint filers) of interest earned by individuals from gross income.

Provides special rules for: (1) distributions from trusts, regulated investment companies, and real estate investment trusts; and (2) nonresident alien eligibility for such exclusion.

Increases the threshold for reporting interest paid from \$10 to \$100.
