Summary (as of Mar 17, 2005)

Independent Living Assistance Access Act of 2005 - Amends the Immigration and Nationality Act to provide J (exchange visitor) nonimmigrant status to aliens working as independent living assistants (defined as individuals who provide inhome living and home support services to adults with disabilities).

Requires aliens accorded such status to receive appropriate training prior to placement.
