### Summary (as of Sep 7, 2005)

Amends the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to suspend, through December 31, 2008, the duty on lon-exchange resins (cationic H form), consisting of copolymers of acrylic acid and diethylene glycol divinyl ether (Lewatit).
