Bill	Relationship Last Action
109 SRES 331	Identical bill Dec 14, 2005: Referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions. (text of measure as introduced: CR S13591)

Expresses the sense of Congress that cancer-related infertility is a serious quality of life issue for cancer patients.

Urges the medical community to increase its efforts to ensure that discussions about the risk of infertility and fertility preservation options are an integral part of pretreatment planning and consent for treatment for all reproductive-age patients.

Calls for the federal government, acting through the National Institutes of Health (NIH), to: (1) encourage research to strengthen fertility preservation technologies; (2) consider ways to improve access to fertility preservation options; and (3) raise awareness about the fertility side effects and preservation options.
