Summary (as of Apr 27, 2005)

Amends the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to impose a duty on triethylene glycol bis[3-(3-tert-butyl-4-hydroxy-5-methylphenyl)propionate] through December 31, 2008 (thus repealing duty-free treatment).
