Summary (as of Apr 28, 2005)

Amends the Internal Revenue Code to exempt from the excise tax on air transportation of persons or property certain transportation provided by seaplanes. Disqualifies seaplanes when using an airport which receives or has received financial assistance from the Airport and Airway Trust Fund.
