Summary (as of May 3, 2005)

Federal Contractor Security Act - Amends the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 to require the following Federal service contractors to participate in a pilot program for employment eligibility confirmation: (1) those contractors required to pay at least minimum wage; and (2) those contractors exempted from the requirements of the Service Contract Act of 1965.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 26, 2005:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR H6440)
- **Jun 6, 2005:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration, Border Security, and Claims.
- **May 20, 2005:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Employer-Employee Relations.
- **May 3, 2005:** Introduced in House
- **May 3, 2005:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
