A bill to provide that pay may not be disbursed to Members of Congress after October 1 of any fiscal year in which all appropriations acts are not passed by Congress, and for other purposes.

Summary (as of Feb 9, 2006)

Prohibits the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) of the House of Representatives from disbursing net pay to any Member of Congress for any pay period, beginning as of the first day of any fiscal year (October 1), if Congress has not passed all final appropriations acts necessary to provide appropriations for the entirety of that fiscal year.

Requires disbursement of all net pay after all such final appropriation acts have been passed.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 28, 2006:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs referred to Subcommittee on Oversight of Government Management, the Federal Workforce, and the District of Columbia.
- **Feb 9, 2006:** Introduced in Senate
