Summary (as of May 3, 2005)

Declares that the House of Representatives: (1) finds that the Committee on the Judiciary purposefully and deliberately mischaracterized five amendments in House Report 109-51; and (2) directs the Chairman of such Committee to report to the House a supplement to such Report that corrects the record by describing the five amendments with nonargumentative, objective captions.

- May 3, 2005: RESOLUTION RAISING QUESTION OF PRIVILEGE Mr. Convers submitted a resolution raising a question of the privileges of the House. Upon examination of the resolution, the Chair determined that the resolution did constitute a question of the privileges of the House and pursuant to rule 9 of the Rules of the House of Representatives, the Chair recognized Mr. Convers and a Member opposed thereto, each for 30 minutes.
