### Summary (as of May 24, 2005)

Amends the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to reduce, through December 31, 2006, the duty on formulations of Azoxystrobin which include Azoxystrobin Technical - benzeneacetic acid, 2-[[6-(2-cyanophenoxy)-4-pyrimidinyl]oxy}-alpha-(Methoxymethylene)-methyl ester,(alphaE)-.

Specifies incremental increases in such duty from: (1) January 1, 2007, through December 31, 2007; and (2) January 1, 2008, through December 31, 2008.
