Summary (as of May 25, 2005)

Amends the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to suspend, through December 31, 2009, the duty on certain: (1) front panels for cathode-ray television picture tubes; (2) 32V funnels for use with curved screen panels; (3) 32V funnels for use with Pure Flat (PF) panels; (4) certain funnels for cathode-ray television picture tubes; (5) preassembled glass envelopes; (6) aperture masks made from aluminum-killed, open-coil annealed steel for color picture tubes; (7) three-beam electron guns for cathode ray tubes; (8) one-beam electron guns for projection cathode-ray tubes; and (9) aperture masks.

Reduces, through such date, the duty on front panels for certain cathode-ray television picture tubes.
