#### Summary (as of May 3, 2006)

Amends the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to suspend, through December 31, 2009, the duty on trans-5-(4-Chlorophenyl)-N-cyclohexyl-4-methyl-2-oxothiazolidine-3-carboxamide (Hexythiazox Technical).
