Summary (as of Jun 15, 2005)

Amends the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to suspend, through December 31, 2008, the duty on formulations of Thiamethoxam, Difenoconazole, Fludioxinil and Mefenoxam which contain: Thiamethoxam Technical 3-[(2-chloro-5-thiazolyl)methyl]tetrahydro-5-methyl-N-nitro- 1,3,5-oxadiazin-4-imine), Difenoconazole Technical 1H-1,2,4-triazole, 1-[[2-[2-chloro-4-(4-chlorophenoxy)phenyl]-4-methyl-1,3-dioxolan-2-yl]methyl]- Fludioxinil Technical 1H-Pyrrole-3-carbonitrile, 4-(2,2-difluoro-1,3-benzodioxol-4-yl)- Mefenoxam Technical (R,S)-2-[(2,6-dimethylphenyl]-methoxyacetylamino]-propionic acid methyl ester.
