### **Summary** (as of May 25, 2006)

Amends the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to provide that certain high-density fiberboard shall include laminate boards or panels bonded in whole or in part, or impregnated with synthetic resins of a density exceeding 0.8g/cm.
