Summary (as of Jan 25, 2005)

Governmental Pension Plan Equalization Act of 2005 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code and the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA) to specify that rules for governmental plans also apply to plans established for their employees by Indian tribal governments or their subdivisions, agencies, instrumentalities, or entities which they wholly-own or control.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 24, 2005:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Employer-Employee Relations.
- **Jan 25, 2005:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 25, 2005:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
