Summary (as of Jul 25, 2005)

Minimum Wage Competitiveness Act of 2005 - Amends the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to increase the federal minimum wage to: (1) \$6.00 an hour, beginning on the 60th day after enactment of this Act; (2) \$6.75 an hour, beginning on January 1, 2006; and (3) \$7.15 an hour, beginning on January 1, 2007.

Makes federal minimum wage requirements applicable to the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands. Sets forth a transition period during which a specified minimum wage there shall be gradually increased to equal the federal minimum wage.
