## Summary (as of Jun 7, 2006)

Children's Gasoline Burn Prevention Act - Directs the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) to promulgate final child-resistance product safety standards for closures on portable gasoline containers intended for use by consumers.

Prescribes criteria for such standards.
