Summary (as of Feb 10, 2005)

Requires the President to appoint two additional permanent district judges and one additional temporary district judge for the District of New Mexico.

States that the first vacancy in the office of district judge in such district occurring ten years or more after confirmation of the temporary district judge shall not be filled.
