(This measure has not been amended since it was reported to the House on October 18, 2005. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Makes Danish nationals eligible to enter the United States as nonimmigrant traders and investors (E-visa) if Denmark extends reciprocal nonimmigrant treatment to U.S. nationals.

(Specifies that the provisions providing E-3 specialty occupation status for nationals of Australia shall not apply to Denmark.)
