Summary (as of Jul 20, 2006)

Makes the survivors of Christopher Kangas of Brookhaven, Pennsylvania, eligible for a specified monetary award to be issued by the Bureau of Justice Assistance of the Department of Justice due to his death as a result of his acting in the capacity of a public safety officer.

Directs the United States Fire Administration to include the name of Christopher Kangas on the National Fallen Firefighters Memorial in Emmitsburg, Maryland.
