Summary (as of Feb 16, 2006)

Amends the Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 to: (1) advance from FY2007 to FY2006 the fiscal year for which funds are appropriated for the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP); and (2) repeal the limitation on such funds as a one-time only obligation and expenditure.

Accelerates the termination of such appropriation and related allocations and conditions from September 30, 2007, to September 30, 2006.
