Justice for Crime Victims' Families Act - Requires the Attorney General to submit to the House and Senate Judiciary Committees reports on measures to: (1) increase the success of federal, state, and local homicide investigations; and (2) improve the ability of federal, state, and local criminal investigators to solve homicides involving missing persons and unidentified human remains.
