Summary (as of Mar 7, 2006)

No Special Deals for Executives Act of 2006 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to require any participant in a taxexempt defined benefit plan which has a funding target attainment percentage of less than 80% to include in gross income the value of assets set aside to pay deferred compensation under a nonqualified deferred compensation plan of the employer maintaining the defined benefit plan.
