Summary (as of Mar 28, 2006)

Nevada Test Site Veterans' Compensation Act of 2006 - Amends the Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act of 2000 to set forth criteria for the inclusion of certain nuclear weapons program workers in the special exposure cohort under the energy employees occupational illness compensation program.

Establishes a deadline for claims adjudication.

Actions Timeline

- **May 24, 2006:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Workforce Protections.
- **Mar 28, 2006:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 28, 2006:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
