Summary (as of Apr 26, 2006)

Professional Educators Tax Relief Act of 2006 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow a tax credit of up to \$1,000 for certain full-time kindergarten through grade 12 (K-12) teachers or other school employees involved in the formulation or implementation of K-12 academic programs.

Amends title II (Old Age, Survivors and Disability Insurance) of the Social Security Act to eliminate the 60-month period of employment requirement for application of the government pension offset exemption.
