Summary (as of Mar 29, 2006)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Condemns the enforcement of laws against apostasy.

Requests the President to continue to work with the government of Afghanistan to establish better protections for religious minorities, including converts to minority religions, and to enhance human rights protections in Afghanistan.

Calls upon the government of Afghanistan, and especially President Hamid Karzai, to continue to conform Afghan laws to Afghanistan's international human rights treaty obligations, thereby protecting from prosecution Afghan citizens who have converted or plan to convert to other religions.

- Mar 29, 2006: Mr. Pence moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- Mar 29, 2006: Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H1281-1283)
- Mar 29, 2006: DEBATE The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 736.
- Mar 29, 2006: At the conclusion of debate, the Yeas and Nays were demanded and ordered. Pursuant to the provisions of clause 8, rule XX, the Chair announced that further proceedings on the motion would be postponed.
