Summary (as of May 10, 2005)

Restoring Safety to Indian Women Act - Amends the Federal criminal code to cover domestic assault by a habitual offender in Indian country.

Amends the Indian Law Enforcement Reform Act to cover a misdemeanor offense of domestic violence involving Indians, including domestic assault against unmarried intimate partners.

Directs the Attorney General to: (1) make pilot project grants for the development of tribal criminal history databases; and (2) study and report to Congress on the incidents of domestic violence in Indian country.

- May 10, 2005: Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR S4873)
- May 10, 2005: Read twice and referred to the Committee on Indian Affairs. (text of measure as introduced: CR S4873-4874)
