Summary (as of Mar 29, 2007)

Provides for an adjournment of the House of Representatives from March 29 or 30, 2007, until April 16, 2007 (or until another time of reassembly under this concurrent resolution), and a recess or an adjournment of the Senate from March 29, 2007, until April 10, 2007 (or until another time of reassembly).

Authorizes the Speaker of the House and the Majority Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting jointly after consultation with the Minority Leaders of the House and of the Senate, to notify the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble at such place and time as they may designate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
