Fair Play-Equal Access in Membership Resolution - Expresses the sense of Congress that neither the President, the Vice President, nor any Member of Congress, federal justice or judge, or political appointee in the executive branch should belong to a club that discriminates on the basis of sex or race.

- **Apr 20, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Constitution, Civil Rights, and Civil Liberties.
- **Mar 30, 2007:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E708)
- **Mar 29, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 29, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committees on House Administration, and the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
