- **May 21, 2008:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **May 19, 2008:** Ms. Bordallo moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.
- **May 19, 2008:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H4069)
- **May 19, 2008:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 1074.
- **May 19, 2008:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Issa objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
- **Apr 2, 2008:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 2, 2008:** Referred to the House Committee on Natural Resources.
