Summary (as of Feb 15, 2007)

Save Our Shores Act - Amends the Harmful Algal Bloom and Hypoxia Research and Control Act of 1998 to extend the authorization of appropriations for research, education, and monitoring activities related to the prevention, reduction, and control of harmful algal blooms and hypoxia.

Requires that all federal financial assistance for harmful algal bloom research be awarded on a competitive, peer reviewed basis.

Actions Timeline

- Feb 23, 2007: Referred to the Subcommittee on Fisheries, Wildlife, and Oceans.
- Feb 21, 2007: Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Environment.
- Feb 15, 2007: Introduced in House
- Feb 15, 2007: Referred to the Committee on Science and Technology, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
