Summary (as of May 20, 2008)

Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6049) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide incentives for energy production and conservation, to extend certain expiring provisions, to provide individual income tax relief.

Actions Timeline

- **May 21, 2008:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H4330-4337)
- **May 21, 2008:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 1212.
- **May 21, 2008:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 1212, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Hastings (WA) demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question on H.Res. 1212 until later in the legislative day.
- **May 21, 2008:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H4346-4347)
- **May 21, 2008:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 223 - 190 (Roll no. 338). (consideration: CR H4346-4347)
- **May 21, 2008:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 223 - 194 (Roll no. 339).(text: CR H4330)
- **May 21, 2008:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 223 - 194 (Roll no. 339). (text: CR H4330)
- **May 21, 2008:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **May 20, 2008:** Introduced in House
- **May 20, 2008:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 110-660, by Mr. Arcuri.
- **May 20, 2008:** The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the bill except those arising under clause 9 and 10 of rule XXI. The amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Ways and Means now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted.
- **May 20, 2008:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 223.
