Summary (as of Feb 27, 2007)

Amends the Energy Policy Act of 2005 to instruct the Secretary of Energy to make loan guarantee commitments to domestic motor vehicle manufacturers and suppliers for advanced conservation and fuel efficiency technology projects for gasoline and diesel vehicles, flexible fuel vehicles, and hybrid electric vehicles that reduce dependence on oil and greenhouse gas emissions.

Limits the aggregate amount of guarantees for such production.

- **Feb 28, 2007:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Air Quality.
- **Feb 27, 2007:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 27, 2007:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Science and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
